

**TOWN OF LINCOLN

The regular monthly meeting was held on April 18, 2017, at the Lincoln Town Hall, immediately following the Annual Meeting.

Present: Steven Washkuhn, Chairman; Joe Peterson, Supervisor; Cory Jackson, Supervisor; Wanda Washkuhn, Clerk; Stacy Gaffney, Treasurer; Jesse Swanson and Allen Steiner.

The meeting was called to order at 6:25 p.m. by Chairman, Steve Washkuhn.

Motion to approve the agenda was made by Joe Peterson, seconded by Cory Jackson. 3-0 motion carried.

Motion to approve minutes from the March 8, 2017 meeting was made by Cory Jackson, seconded by Joe Peterson. 3-0 motion carried.

Motion was made to approve the Treasurer report for the month of March by Joe Peterson, seconded by Cory Jackson. 3-0 motion carried.

Fire Chief Allen Steiner gave official oath. Motion to accept the oath was made by Joe Peterson, seconded by Cory Jackson. 3-0 motion carried.

Brittany Fry was not present, so moved to next agenda item.

Public Comments: Allen Steiner asked if it would be possible to install markers on the culverts to prevent them from getting hit. The Board will discuss at a later date.

Comprehensive Plan: The plan is now complete. A public hearing will be held on June 14, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.

Brittany Fry from Burnett County Health Services was present to hand out five water sample kits. The kits were obtained through a grant for arsenic testing. Kits were distributed, and will need to be dropped off at Burnett County Health Services. Results will be mailed to participants.

Road Maintenance: Jesse is now working another fulltime job, but plans to continue to work for the Township on evenings and/or weekends. Patching will need to be done as it warms up. Steve recommended that he use the Selvix product. Roads are in need of grading when it dries up. Weight restriction signs have been removed as the restriction was lifted as of 4/17/17.

Perida Cemetery is in need of work. There are limbs/branches that need to be cleaned up. The fence is in need of repair also. Jesse will get to that project soon. The shop needs to be cleaned up, as well as the equipment. The Board will discuss at a later date, the condition of the town dump truck. Olinger road could use more gravel in spots. Heier road appears to be in good shape, but Lhotka is in need of grading.

Steve was informed that Lincoln was not chosen for the Forestry Grant which he had applied for. The funds were awarded to Union and Swiss Townships. Steve will apply again next year for the same grant.

Annual Road Tour is set for April 25, 2017. Steve, Jesse, Joe and Cory will meet at the town hall at 5:30 p.m.

Board of Review has been scheduled for May 31, 2017. Open book from 3:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m., and Board of Review from 5:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Board members discussed a possible Noise Ordinance for the Town of Lincoln. Wanda will check other noise ordinances and have a draft ready for next meeting.

Correspondence was looked over.

Motion to approve monthly bills as presented was made by Joe Peterson, seconded by Cory Jackson. 3-0 motion carried.
