Public comments: Bob Pardun inquired about possible improvements to Olsen Road. The board responded that Olsen road is in the top 2-3 roads for repair/replacement. It was further explained that it would be out several years. It was also noted that Jim will be doing some repair work on Olsen Road as soon as weather conditions improve.

Road Maintenance: Jim is waiting to hear back from the Fire Department as to the broken suction pipe on Ice House Bridge. He has been busy plowing. There is a culvert on the curve of Nelson Road that is in need of repair. One of the chevron signs on the curve of Ice House Bridge road (just west of intersection of Black Brook & Ice House Bridge Road) has been knocked down. Jim has been registered and will be attending the Mine Safety Training at the Burnett County Highway Department on April 19, 2018. Patching will need to be done when weather permits. Steve recommended that he use Silvex for patching material as it holds up much better.

Annual road tour has been scheduled for Wednesday, May 2, 2018 at 4:30 p.m.

Board of Review has been set for May 9, 2018 from 4:30 – 6:30 pm. Open book is scheduled for May 2, 2018 from 10:00 a.m. until noon. Both Steve & Wanda are certified for Board of Review.
