TOWN OF LINCOLN BURNETT COUNTY WISCONSIN

DRIVEWAY ORDINANCE

We the undersigned Town Board of the Town of Lincoln, Burnett County, Wisconsin, do hereby establish standards for driveways that will provide for better and safer provisions for access from private development to a public right of way.

All new driveways proposed to be installed shall require authorization by the Town Board or its designee.

The driveway within the area of the public right of way shall:

- 1. Have a driveway permit issued from the Town Chairman.
- 2. Slope away from the public road to prevent erosion onto the public road.
- 3. Have an adequate road bed base of suitable material to support the projected traffic and protect the public road from damage.
- 4. The requirement for a culvert will be determined by the Town Board or its designees and will be a minimum of 12" diameter. Larger diameters may be required.
- 5. Meet the standards set forth by the Burnett County driveway ordinance.
