Road Maintenance: Discussion on the recent road tour was held. Steve provided a summary of the results. Steve advised the board that the County is scheduling dates for grinding, and if the Town of Lincoln was interested in any grinding now would be the time to do it. It was decided to grind north Klarquist and Hilda's Corner. Culverts are needed on North Fork Dike road and Corcoran road. It was decided to have the culverts replaced with plastic culverts. A culvert will also be ordered for a resident on Klarquist for their driveway. Once the township is billed for it, they will then bill the landowner. Jim has been doing some patching. Weight limits have been lifted. Welch Road has a sand pocket in need of repair.

Steve received a phone call from Tom O'Brien, Chairman for the Town of Meenon, regarding Corcoran Road, as portions are in both Lincoln and Meenon. There is a culvert that is in need

of repair. There is an official road map that defines the portions between the townships. The culvert is in Lincoln's section and will be replaced.

Correspondence was looked over.
