The Annual Town Meeting was held on Tuesday, April 21, 2026, at 6:00pm, at the Lincoln Town Hall located at 9110 Perida Road, Webster, Wisconsin.

Members Present: Steve Washkuhn, Joe Peterson, Dale Larson, Stacy Gaffney

Absent: Jenelle Lindquist, Clerk

Public: Bob Pardun, Judy Larson, Linda Isaacson, Charlie Strabel, Wanda Washkuhn, Claudia Kurschner (arrived later)

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman, Steve Washkuhn.

Motion to approve the agenda order was made by Charlie Strabel, seconded by Dale Larson. 9-0 motion carried.

Chairman, Steve Washkuhn asked for preference on voting procedure of either show of right hand or ballot. The motion for show of hand was made by Joe Peterson, seconded by Judy Larson. 9-0 motion carried.

The 2025 Clerk's Financial Detail report was presented. The ending bank balance matches that of the Treasurer. Motion to approve the report as presented was made by Wanda Washkuhn, seconded by Judy Larson. 9-0 motion carried.

Claudia Kurschner arrived, making 10 people in participation for the annual meeting.

Stacy presented the 2025 annual Treasurer's report. The ending bank balance matches that of the Clerk. Motion to approve the report as presented by Charlie Strabel seconded by Dale Larson. 10-0 motion carried.

Newspaper Advertising: The Township posts notices in the Indianhead Advertiser for required notices by State Statute. All other notices are posted at the Town Hall, and our website. Motion to continue this practice by, Stacy Gaffney seconded by Charlie Strabel. 10-0 motion carried.

Sale of Misc Items: The Town of Lincoln Board currently has the authority to sell items under \$500. A motion to continue this practice was made by Joe Peterson, seconded by Judy Larson. 10-0 motion carried.

Cemeteries: A discussion was held in regard to costs for new fencing at Perida Cemetery. Being there wasn't anyone from the cemetery committee at the annual meeting. The fencing conversation was tabled. Current gravesite costs are \$250. Motion to keep the cost the same at \$250.00 per grave site by Stacy Gaffney, seconded by Judy Larson. 10-0 motion carried.

Cemetery clean up day was set for Wednesday, May 6, 2026 at 5pm. Meet at Perida Cemetery.

Bounties: Current rate on bounties is \$20.00 for beavers and \$2.00 for Pocket Gophers. Motion to keep the bounties the same by Joe Peterson, seconded by Charlie Strabel. 10-0 motion carried.

Salaries: Chairman's salary currently is \$5,250.00 per year. Motion by Joe Peterson seconded by Charlie Strabel to leave the Chairman's salary the same at \$5,250.00 per year. 10-0 motion carried.

The supervisor's salary is currently \$4,250 per year. Motion by Steve Washkuhn seconded by Charlie Strabel to leave the supervisor's salary the same at \$4,250 per year. 10-0 motion carried.

Election Workers receive \$15.00 per hour. Motion by Wanda Washkuhn, seconded by Stacy Gaffney to leave the election workers wage the same at \$15.00 per hour. 10-0 motion carried.

The Chief Election Inspector receives \$17.00 per hour. Motion by Wanda Washkuhn, seconded by Judy Larson to leave the chief election inspector wage the same at \$17.00 per hour. 10-0 motion carried.

The standard labor rate is currently \$17.00. Motion to leave the labor rate at \$17.00 by Joe Peterson, seconded by Judy Larson. 10-0 motion carried.

The Township has historically followed the federal mileage reimbursement rate. A motion was made to continue following the federal mileage rate. Motion by Stacy Gaffney, seconded by Charlie Strabel. 10-0 motion carried.

Public Comments: Bob Pardun suggested the future land use map on the wall of the town hall be updated to reflect the town's ordinance of 10-acre minimums. Stacy will consult with Jason Towne regarding the process for making updates and will look at coordinating another comprehensive plan committee meeting, as Charlie Strabel noted a potential requirement to hold at least one meeting per year. Steve will contact Charmoli's to determine their interest in still participating on the committee.

Judy Larson inquired about the Voter Registration District Map potentially being incorrect and outdated. Stacy will request information regarding the map from Tia Bowe at the county Land Services department.

Motion by Joe Peterson seconded by Charlie Strabel to set the 2026 annual meeting for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of April (April 20, 2026) at 6:00 p.m. 10-0 motion carried.

A motion to adjourn was made by Dale Larson, seconded by Charlie Strabel. 10-0 motion carried.
